COMMUNICATION

Information regarding the following events will be communicated by the Principal to the Board of Directors no later than the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Directors following the occurrence of such event:

1. A child who is receiving special education services receives a second or third "violation" or "strike" pursuant to ARPS's discipline policies.
2. Parents of a child who is receiving special education services express an intention to appeal or otherwise dispute a proposed change to such child's IEP.
3. Events transpire such that the Principal comes to the conclusion that the special education and other services currently offered at ARPS are not adequate to meet the particular needs of a child who is receiving special education services.

Information regarding the following events will be communicated by the Principal to the President of the Board of Directors (or the Vice President or other officer of the Board of Directors if the President is not available) immediately following the occurrence of such event:

1. Events transpire such that the Principal comes to the conclusion that there exists a potential danger of injury or other serious harm to ARPS students, teachers, employees, or other persons at ARPS.
2. A person threatens to initiate legal action against ARPS, or threatens to initiate legal action against a ARPS employee or student as a result of events occurring at ARPS.
