SCHOOL PROPERTIES DISPOSITION

The Board of Directors has the authority to sell or lease any property which may not be needed in the foreseeable future. It is not required that bids be sought, but it is advisable in the interest of good business.

If the property is sold to a state agency or political subdivision of the state, it shall not be necessary to find that the property may not be needed.

The Board of Directors will be advised of any books, equipment, or supplies that are worn out or are to be declared surplus and no longer needed in the school. Prior approval from the Board of Directors shall be required for removal from inventory and disposal or sale of any books, equipment, or supplies. Outdated textbooks or library books may be disposed of by notifying the Board of Directors. School markings shall be obliterated prior to such disposal.
