## **INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCES AND MATERIALS**

The Aspen Ridge Preparatory School Board of Directors is responsible for the selection of all instructional materials. Aspen Ridge Preparatory School Board of Directors delegates to the Aspen Ridge Preparatory School Curriculum Committee the authority to research and recommend the instructional resources and materials, library materials, media and computer programs to be used to supplement the curriculum. These instructional resources and content-rich materials will also include literary and art appreciation, and character development, and may include materials about local and state history.

Materials for the classroom texts shall be selected by the Curriculum Committee in consultation with the Principal, faculty and parents of the students. The final decision on the purchase of Curriculum materials shall rest with the Aspen Ridge Preparatory School Board of Directors.

This policy shall serve as a guide in the selection of all instructional materials, with the Curriculum Committee serving as a review committee in all areas as needed.
