Supplementary Materials Selection and Adoption Questions for Teachers

When using film resources and other supplemental sources, teachers shall be prepared to respond to the following questions:

- a) What is the rating of the film?
- b) Will this resource enrich and support the educational objectives of the curriculum, taking into consideration the varied interests, abilities, intellectual development and maturity levels of the pupils, and the standards of the community?
- c) Does the resource contain any violence, nudity, or language which may be offensive or profane? In the case of films, can those parts be edited out?
- d) What are the connections between the resource and content standards?
- e) What are the instructional goals?
- f) What alternative activities will be assigned for those students who do not have permission to view the film resource or access the supplemental resource?
- g) How will classroom discussion of the material include students who participated in the alternative activity?
