## **STUDENT UNIFORMS**

Although uniforms may be purchased at the store of your choice, the preferred vendor for ARPS is **Lands' End**. If purchased from a different retailer, the colors and styles must match those of Lands' End to keep continuity in the ARPS uniform. The school administrator will have the final decision on whether or not a piece of clothing meets the uniform code.

Lands' End produces high quality uniform pieces at moderate prices and offer a variety of sizes including slim, regular, and husky. The pants also have a hidden adjustable waist and Lands' End will hem pants for free for the perfect fit. Purchases can be made 24 hours a day by phone or on their website. In addition, uniform pieces may be purchased and returned at your local Sears store.

Lands' End gives a percentage **of net sales back to the school** as a school fundraiser. Simply provide ARPS Preferred School Code when making purchases online, over the phone, or in store.

### **When to Wear the Uniform**

Students are expected to come to school in a clean, properly-fitting uniform each morning. The uniform is to be worn properly until the student leaves school grounds. Students are also expected to wear proper uniforms on field trips away from school grounds.

### **Unisex Bottoms**

- Khaki or Navy pants or shorts in cotton twill
- No denim (except on designated "jeans day")
- No Corduroy

### **Unisex Tops**

- Any long or short-sleeve polo shirt from Lands' End in the following colors:
  - Evergreen
  - White
  - Maize (gold)
  - Classic Navy
  - Chambray Blue (light blue)
  - If purchasing from a place other than Lands' End, shirt must not have any logo (except ARPS) and must match the Lands' End uniform selections.
- Any long or short-sleeved oxford style shirt in White, Chamois, or Blue
- "Drifter" zip up cardigan sweater in Navy or Evergreen
- "Drifter" crew sweater in Navy or Evergreen
- "Drifter" cardigan in Navy or Evergreen
- Uniform zipper fleece jacket in Navy

### **Boys**

- Short or long-sleeved oxford style shirt in Hunter/Classic Navy plaid
  - "Drifter" V Neck sweater in Evergreen or Navy
  - "Drifter V Neck sweater vest in Evergreen or Navy
  - The V Neck Sweater may be worn over a polo or oxford shirt
  - The Sweater vest may be worn only with Oxford style shirt underneath
- \*All sweaters must be worn with approved uniform shirt underneath

### **Girls**

- Cotton Cardigan Sweater in Evergreen or Navy
- Ruffle Front Cardigan sweater in Evergreen
- Oxford style blouse with Peter Pan collar (long or short sleeves) in white, chamois, or blue
- No capri/crop pants
- Uniform Girls' Plaid jumper in Hunter/Classic Navy Plaid with peter pan collar white oxford shirt underneath
- Short or long sleeved polo dress in Chambray Blue (light blue), Navy or Evergreen
- Girls Jumper (Knit Wrap Jumper or Girls' Uniform Jumper) in solid Khaki or Navy
- Girls Knit Wrap Skort in solid Khaki or Navy
- Girls Short Chino Skirt in solid Khaki or Navy



### **Shoes**

Shoes may not detract from the uniform

- If shoes have holes for laces, laces must be worn and tied properly
- No lights
- No boots or high-tops (except snow boots for recess and before/after school.)
- Snow boots may not be worn in the classroom. Once the student is in the classroom, they need school uniform shoes to change into. Snow boots will be worn on the playground only on snowy days.
- No Crocs or Croc type shoes
- No flip-flops or sandals
- No heel above 1"/no platforms

### **Socks and Tights**

- Socks must be worn with all shoes and must be above ankle or knee length (no footies or athletic socks.)
- Sock colors: Any solid color sock with no lace, decoration, or other colors on the sock
- Tights or knee-highs (may be any solid color and may be cable-knit or plain.)

### **Accessories**

- Belts are optional and must be in shades of brown, black, or navy.
- Hair accessories may be worn in any color that compliments the uniform and may not cause distraction in the classroom.

### **General Uniform Rules**

- ARPS logo on uniform shirts is optional
- Skirts, skorts, dresses, jumpers and shorts must be at least fingertip length for both boys and girls
- Cold weather gear (jackets, gloves, hats, scarves, snow boots), backpacks and lunch boxes are student choice- must be in good taste and have no obscene or objectionable language/graphics, etc.
- No underwear showing
- Undershirts may not be visible below the sleeve of the uniform shirt or through the uniform shirt



- No distracting accessories
- One small earring per ear (worn on the lobe) is allowed
- No makeup allowed except nail polish in a light color and clear lip gloss- (**must not be brought to school**)
- No jackets worn in the classroom except uniform Fleece or uniform sweater
- No hats or hoods- except outerwear for cold weather (removed in the classroom.)

#### **Dress Code for Casual/ "Jeans Days"**

- Pants or jeans may be worn
- Shirts may not have advertising besides designer logos Shirts may not have obscene/double meaning slogans
- Midriff must be covered
- No tank tops
- Socks are required
- No sandals
